follow these top tips.

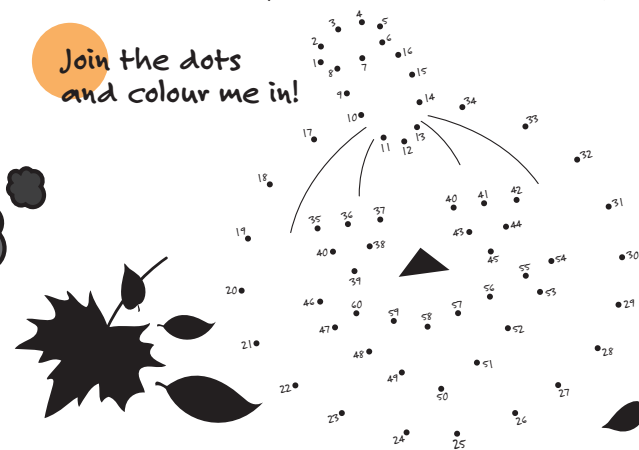


Sooty and Flash would like you to colour in the Byrnes family then draw a star next to your favourite.

NEVER play with matches or lighters – if you see matches or lighters lying around tell a grown-up straight away.

Stay well away from fireworks and bonfires – you could get hurt if you get too close. Make sure other children and pets stay away too!



If your clothes catch fire, remember:



STOP where you are
DROP to the ground
ROLL around to put the fire out

If someone gets burnt, remember:



COOL the burn with cold water
CALL 999
COVER with loose cling film

Wearing gloves when you hold sparklers and never picking up used sparklers is smart thinking!



Using battery operated candles in your pumpkin lanterns is safe but it also means they won't blow out!



Be smart by keeping a safe distance from bonfires and fireworks and remember to look after pets and wild animals too.



Having a grown-up as part of your trick or treat fun means you'll be safe and be seen.



Check to make sure your costume is flame proof and not made of things that easily catch fire, like bin liners!



Attending public firework displays is smart - it means bigger and longer displays!
