Who is it for?

Use with children in EYFS/Reception and Year 1 or 2

Can be used with a range of ages to practise number formation

What is it?

A resource which assists with number identification/formation (1 -10) and also encourages children to count and record.

Curriculum links:

Key Stage 1

Read and write numbers from 1 – 10 in numerals and words.

Identify and represent numbers using images and pictures

Mandy's Top Tips (Mandy shares these with Elsa and Woody!)

- Children can colour the numbers to assist with identification
- Children can use playdoh or plasticine to create the numbers using the sheets as a guide
- Children can draw or trace the numbers
- Each resource has a 'Did you know...?' fact of an 'Ask a grown up' that reminds your child about an important safety messages

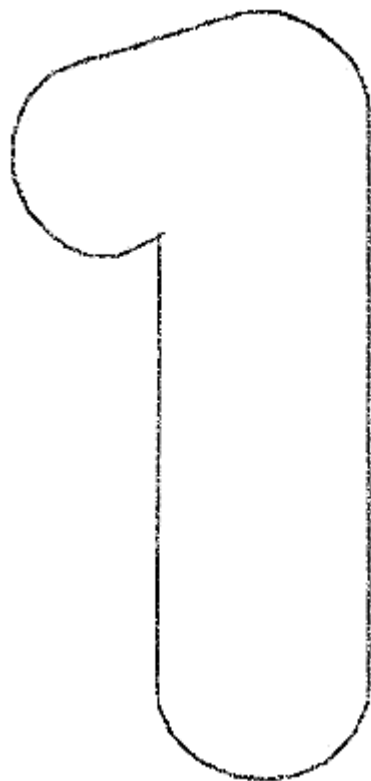
