## What is it?

Ambulance Service, Fire Service, Police and Coastguard.

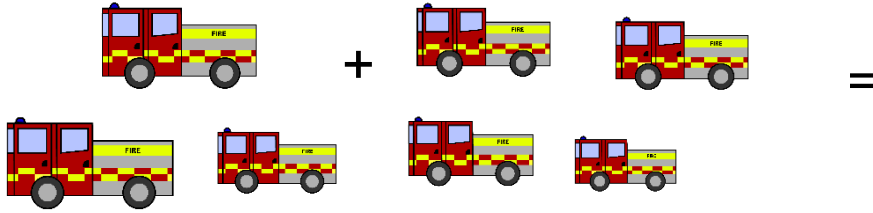

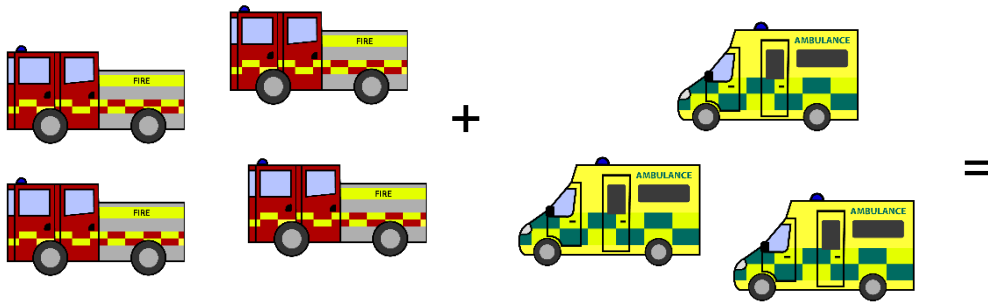

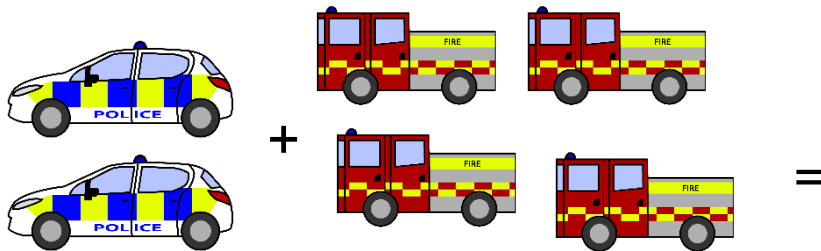
